Monday – There is One God

*Read: Deuteronomy 4:39, 6:4; Exodus 20:3; Isaiah 44:6, 45:5*

Tuesday – God in three distinct persons: co-equal and co-eternal

*Read: Matthew 3:16-17, 28:16-20, 2 Corinthians 13:14,  
(Genesis 1:1-2 with John 1:1-5); John 14:25-26*

Wednesday – One Being or Essence – All have the same attributes

*Eternal – Revelation 1:8, John 1:1, Hebrews 9:14  
Omniscient – Psalm 147:5, John 4:29, 1 Corinthians 2:10-11*

Thursday – One Being or Essence – All have the same attributes

*Omnipresent – Psalm 139:7, Matthew 28:20, John 14:16-17  
Omnipotent – Luke 1:37, Matthew 28:18, Luke 1:35*

Friday – Father, Son, Holy Spirit all present in Relation:

*To Creation – Acts 17:24, Colossians 1:16, Job 33:4, Genesis 1:1-2  
To Revelation – John 1:14, 14:9, 16:13; Romans 1:20, 2 Peter 1:20-21*

Saturday – Father, Son, Holy Spirit all present in Relation:

*To Salvation – John 3:16, 3:5-8, 1 Peter 3:18, Romans 8:9, Matthew 1:20-21  
To the Church – Acts 1:8; 20:28; Matthew 16:18; Ephesians 1:22-23, 5:25-27, 1 Corinthians 12:7*
