Saturday – Read: 2 Timothy 2:11-13; Hebrews 10:23; 1 Peter 4:16-19

***Do you trust in the faithfulness of God? (Jeremiah 29:11) Do you believe in the goodness of God? (Romans 8:28) What can you point to in your own life that reveals the faith/trust that you have in God? What promises of God encourage you? Are there promises of God that discourage you? Why?
